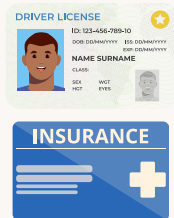
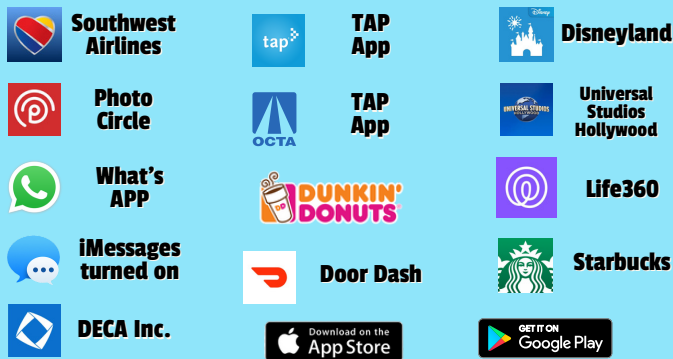

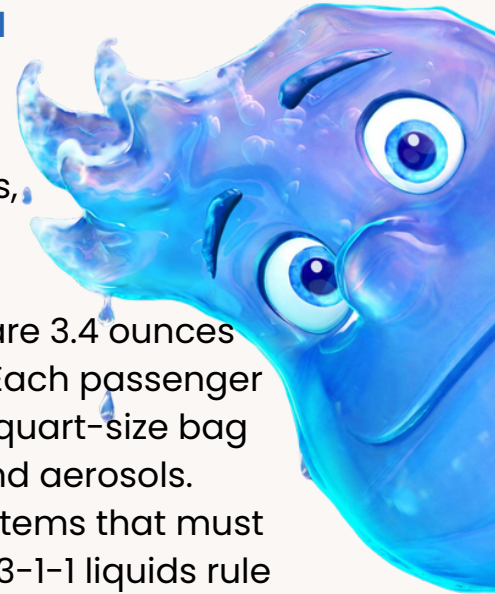
TIP: TEXT YOUR FLIGHT NUMBERS TO YOUR PARENTS

WHAT IS CONSIDERED A LIQUID?

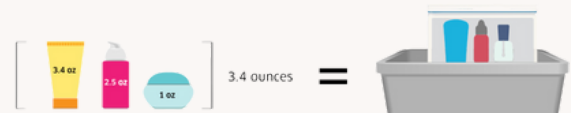
What is the 3-1-1 liquids rule?

Each passenger may carry liquids, gels, aerosols in travel-size containers that are 3.4 ounces or 100 milliliters. Each passenger is limited to one quart-size bag of liquids, gels and aerosols. Common travel items that must comply with the 3-1-1 liquids rule include toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, mouthwash and lotion.



Carry-On Bag

3.4 ounces (100 ml) or smaller sized containers that fit in 1 quart-sized, resealable bag may go in carry-on and through checkpoint security.



Checked Bag

Containers that are larger than 3.4 ounces (100ml) regardless of amount inside must be in checked baggage.



It does not have to be a fancy clear bag. It can be a quart zip loc bag.

Make sure containers are 3.4 oz. or less

*TIP

Place this bag where it is easy to take out or your carry on when putting your bag through security.

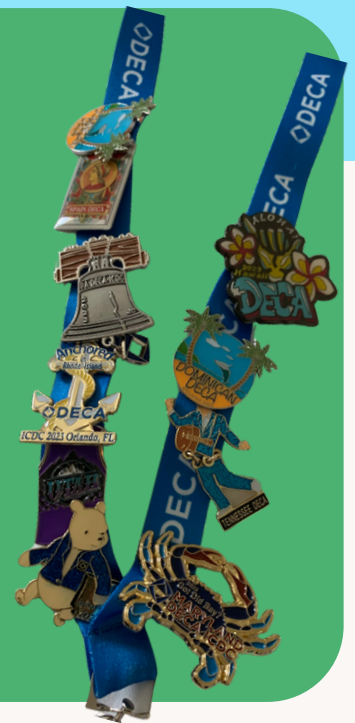

Safety Tips for touring Los Angeles and Surrounding Areas



- Stay Alert and always travel in groups.
- When walking, do not be on your phone or carrying your phone in your hand when touring. Only have your phone out if you are taking photos.
- Pay attention to what is going on around you.
- Only carry what is necessary on your person. (example: ID, credit card, small amount of cash needed for the day) DO NOT carry all your money/cash with you at all times.
- Share your location with a family member through free apps such as Life360.
- Do not keep your phone or money in your back pocket. Again, only carry a small amount on your person that you need for the day. Put money in money belt under clothes or keep everything in your front pockets only (including your phone)

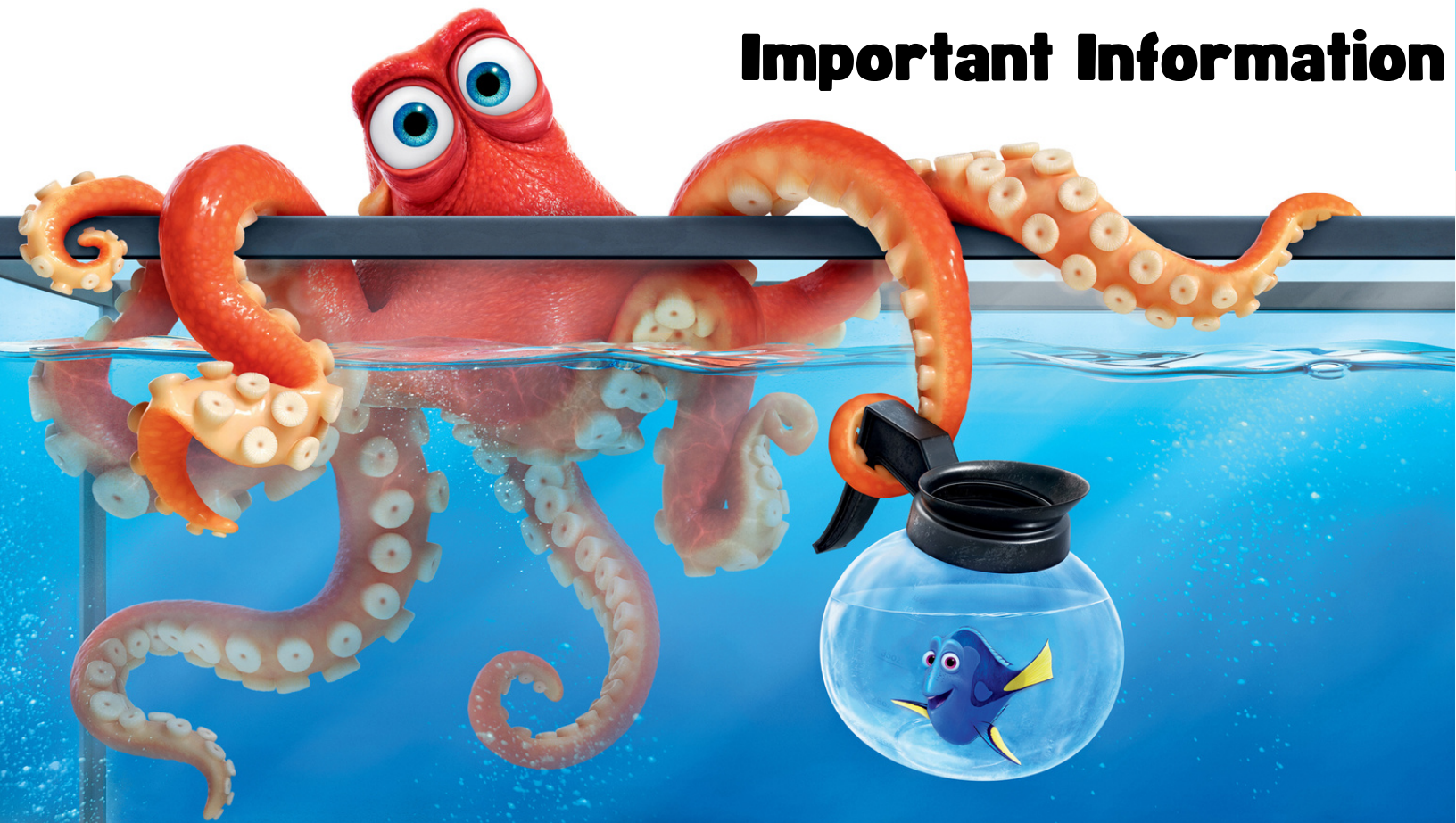
