WORDS OF WISDOM

As this year begins, let's take a moment to listen to some wise words from leaders in our community. Often times we condense DECA to a simple school club, but it is so much more than that. There is a growing need for leaders and innovators all around us. How does DECA make a Difference?

Eric Wooldridge

Mechanical and Architectual Engineer, Architect, Director of Additive Manufacturing at Somerset Community College

Why does knowing how to interview matter?

"Interviewing is the gateway into the industry, Everyone should always bringing your best to the interviewing room or to a DECA pitch. Preparation is the best way to begin. I always recommend that interviewees do practice rounds with others, watch videos of interviews, and treat it as if your wages depend on it (which they do). Never underestimate the power of a good impression and how it can directly relate to a lifetime of career success."

What is the best way to make a good impression?

"Humans are emotional creatures, and the more relatable you are to the employer, the more positive emotions you will invoke, and the better the potential outcome for you professionally. Take it seriously, dress well, do your homework, and rehearse, and you might find that your first job opens a doorway in the future to your dream job."

What is the need for Innovation? Does it really matter?

"Let's face it, private companies are launching rockets right now, building robots, and creating self driving cars, who doesn't want to part of something like? But more importantly, our nation is declining in terms of innovation. The number of American patents has been declining for years. There are new inventions to be made, new material combinations to be discovered, new medicines to be synthesized. Who's to say it can't be you? These things are not going to happen without new minds and hands entering the industrial arena and gaining diverse experiences that will ultimately lead to new mental connections and inspiration to try something new. I am a big fan of taking a risk and trying something new. One either accomplishes their goal, or they learn something about themselves and what doesn't work. Either case it is a win."
